



A HOME FOR OUR FUTURE

As Redemption Hill continues to grow, we will experience greater opportunities to meet the unique needs of every generation in our church: Redemption Kids, Redemption Students, Young Adults, Families, and Seasoned Saints.

Reaching more people will only help us start more churches in the years to come, beginning with Tewksbury (Fall 2025).

The opportunities are limitless, but we understand this vision will require God's supernatural provision!

GOD'S PROVISION: FUNDING THE DREAM

We anticipate raising over 1 million dollars through a building fund campaign!

Where God leads, God provides. He already sees our future home and knows exactly how he will provide for it. While we pray for an amazing, miraculous, "God story," we are also carefully constructing a reasonable and sustainable financial plan.

Our initial funding will help position us with funds for a down payment for a purchase or the financial stream to secure a long-term lease. This will be accomplished through the collective, sacrificial gifts of RHC individuals and families giving over and above what they regularly give to the Financial Ministry Plan (aka operational budget).

We will also pursue grants, partnerships, savings, and potential creative options for revenue streams, and this does not include the countless individuals and partners who desire to see us thrive as we reach Greater Boston with the gospel!

OUR NEXT STEPS

There are a number of factors that will tell us we are ready for our new home! They include positive answers to questions like:

- Are we being Spirit-led through prayer, discernment and unified agreement?
- Would the potential location fuel our vision as a church?
- Are we experiencing momentum, growing deeper and wider?
- Do our Staff & Leadership Teams display health and excitement to move forward?
- Have we seen God's financial provision through internal gifts & external donors?
- Did we complete a diligent process marked by integrity, wisdom, and transparency?

And there's one more crucial question...

Are our people excited to move forward with support, commitment, and sacrifice?

To answer that question, we want to hear from you! Here's how you can help...

- 1. <u>Pray</u> that God would guide RHC on this faith-filled journey and lead each one of us toward our role in its future.
- 2. <u>Participate</u> in a church-wide readiness assessment through a confidential, anonymous questionnaire conducted by a third party church advisor.
- 3. <u>Get Ready</u> as we hear and adapt to feedback from the congregation, we anticipate entering a time of fundraising in early 2025 unless the Lord directs us differently.
